

Pursuant to public vote, the Board may vote to convene into executive session for discussion or consultation for legal advice with its attorney concerning any of the agenda matters or for position in pending or contemplated litigation pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.03 (A) and (B).

During the public meeting, the Board may afford any person, their duly authorized representative, or both, the opportunity to present statements relating to agenda items, with or without the opportunity to present them orally.
