Thank you for your interest in becoming a camp host with the Ben Avery Shooting Facility Main-Range Camp Host Program. Hosts provide a valuable service for the facility and its customers. In exchange for 20 hours of work a week for one resident per living site, or 24 total hours a week for two residents, the host (s) is/are allowed to live at the Ben Avery Shooting Facility. Host sites have water, electricity, and sewage, and there are on site laundry facilities. Most hosts stay at the facility from October-April, but there are a few host positions open year round.

Most host duties are required to be completed between Mondays and Wednesdays. The facility is closed on Mondays and Tuesdays to the public so these are the days the majority of the work is accomplished. Additionally, you will be required to work about an hour daily between Wednesdays and Sundays for spot clean up and restocking of bathroom supplies. All hosts are expected to work all day the last weekend in March in support of the Arizona Game and Fish Department's annual Outdoor Expo.

Maintenance and landscaping duties are as follows:

- Cleaning of bathroom toilets, sinks, toilet stalls and partitions, mirrors and windows
- Replenishment of toilet tissue, hand towels and soap
- Sweeping and mopping of all floors
- Dusting counters and all hard surfaces in buildings
- Arrange tables and chairs as needed
- Trimming tree canopies up to a height of seven feet
- Raking debris and gravel
- Mowing and edge trimming lawns
- Vegetation and cacti planting
- Trimming shrubs
- Weeding the shooting ranges
- Emptying range trash bins
