

Arizona Waters Affected by Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) Listed on the AGFD Director's Orders

Current AIS Affected Waters

● Quagga Mussel: Lake Mead; Lake Mohave; Lake Havasu; Lower Colorado River below Lake Havasu to Mexico; Central AZ Project Canal; Lake Powell; Lake Pleasant; Red Mountain Lake.

● New Zealand Mudsnil: Glen Canyon Dam to Lee's Ferry; Lake Mead; Lake Mohave.

● Apple Snail: Lower Colorado River below Imperial Dam to Mexico; Lower Salt River.

● Didymo: Lower Colorado River below Davis Dam.

● Giant Salvinia: Lower Colorado River below Cibola Lake to Mexico.

● Whirling Disease: Glen Canyon Dam to Lee's Ferry.

● Largemouth Bass Virus: Lake Pleasant; Bartlett Lake; Saguaro Lake; Roosevelt Lake.
