

***Arizona Aquatic Stocking Permit
Disease-Parasite-Pathogen Certification Stipulations
Per R12-4-410
2010***

The licensed fish farm or other facility where source fish were raised or reared, must be certified free of the diseases and causative agents specified below. Certification must be performed within 12 months of the date of stocking unless otherwise stipulated. If fish are brokered from other facilities, certification MUST be included for all facilities where subject fish were held.

All species must be certified free of the following:

Egtved Virus, Viral Hemorrhagic Septicemia Virus (VHS)

If stocking Cold water species (i.e. trout, grayling, char) must also certify for:

Whirling Disease - *Myxobolus cerebralis*
Bacterial Kidney Disease – *Renibacterium salmoniarum*
Furnunculosis – *Aeromonas salmonicida*
Ceratomyxosis of Salmonids – *Ceratomyxa shasta*
Infectious Pancreatic Necrosis Virus – IPN of Salmonids
Infectious Hematopoietic Necrosis Virus – IHN of Salmonids
Enteric Redmouth ERM - *Yersinia ruckeri*

If stocking the following Warm water species must also certify for:

Carp -- Spring Viremia of carp – SVC *Rhabdovirus carpio*

Largemouth and smallmouth bass -- Largemouth Bass Virus - LMBV Iridoviridae family
- *Iridovirus, Chloriridovirus, Ranavirus* and *Lymphocystisvirus*

Channel Catfish -- Channel Catfish Virus – CCVD Herpesvirus family

All fish deliveries must be free of all non-target organisms including other non-authorized fish species, crayfish, plants, snails, mussels, etc.

Fish cannot be stocked from a facility undergoing any type of epizootic disease or parasite event whether or not the disease or causative agents are listed above.
